Viticulture	Ploughed land. No chemical weed control. Sensible phytosanitary control.
Winemaking	Pneumatic pressing. Fermentation on fine lees, in oak barrels, with regular stirring.
Ageing	Bottled after 18 months of ageing, including 12 in barrels (30% new barrels) and slight clarification.
Tasting notes	Golden yellow colour, with beautiful clarity. An elegant nose, offering floral and mineral aromas. Full-bodied and powerful on the palate, with a beautiful balance.
