TASTING NOTES

Very intense, with aromas of red and black fruit and notes of spices and mocha, good acidity, structure and great complexity. Abundant tannins, very fine, creamy palate from the barrel fermentation. A steel fist in a velvet glove.

VINIFICATION

The top of the Boa vista vineyard, called Outeiro, has consistently produced wines of great character and depth, from the two varieties planted there, originating wines with a sense of "terroir". The natural co-fermentation took place in small tanks for 5 days. It was finished in new American oak barrels, with periodic battonage and subsequent ageing of 22 months.
